## Rome & Tuscany | June 22–July 1, 2026

### ***Rome | June 22–24***

#### **Day 1 — Monday, June 22**

Arrival in Rome. Courtyard welcome at Donna Camilla Savelli in Trastevere, followed by a relaxed aperitivo and dinner at a neighborhood restaurant.

#### **Day 2 — Tuesday, June 23**

Leisurely walk through Trastevere and visit to a local market. Free time to rest or explore independently. Group dinner at a carefully chosen local restaurant.

#### **Day 3 — Wednesday, June 24**

Morning at your own pace before transferring to Tuscany. Arrival at Casanova di Neri with a welcome lunch at the estate. Evening at leisure.

### ***Tuscany | June 24–29***

#### **Day 4 — Thursday, June 25**

Winery tour and tasting at the estate. Relaxed afternoon surrounded by vineyards. Wine dinner at the estate.

#### **Day 5 — Friday, June 26**

Day trip to Montalcino to visit local artisans, with time to wander and lunch in town. Dinner at a local restaurant.

#### **Day 6 — Saturday, June 27**

Visit to Bagno Vignoni with optional spa or golf time. Dinner at the estate.

#### **Day 7 — Sunday, June 28**

Hands-on Tuscan cooking experience, followed by olive oil and wine tastings. Optional countryside walk or light yoga.

### ***Rome | June 29–July 1***

#### **Day 8 — Monday, June 29**

Transfer back to Rome. Evening boat cruise on the Tiber timed with the June 29 fireworks celebrating Rome's patron saints.

**Day 9 — Tuesday, June 30**

Free day in Rome for independent exploring or relaxing. Optional suggestions provided.

**Day 10 — Wednesday, July 1**

Final relaxed gathering and departures, timed to flights.

Rome (Trastevere): Donna Camilla Savelli — restored former convent overlooking Trastevere.

Tuscany (Montalcino): Casanova di Neri — renowned Brunello estate surrounded by vineyards.
